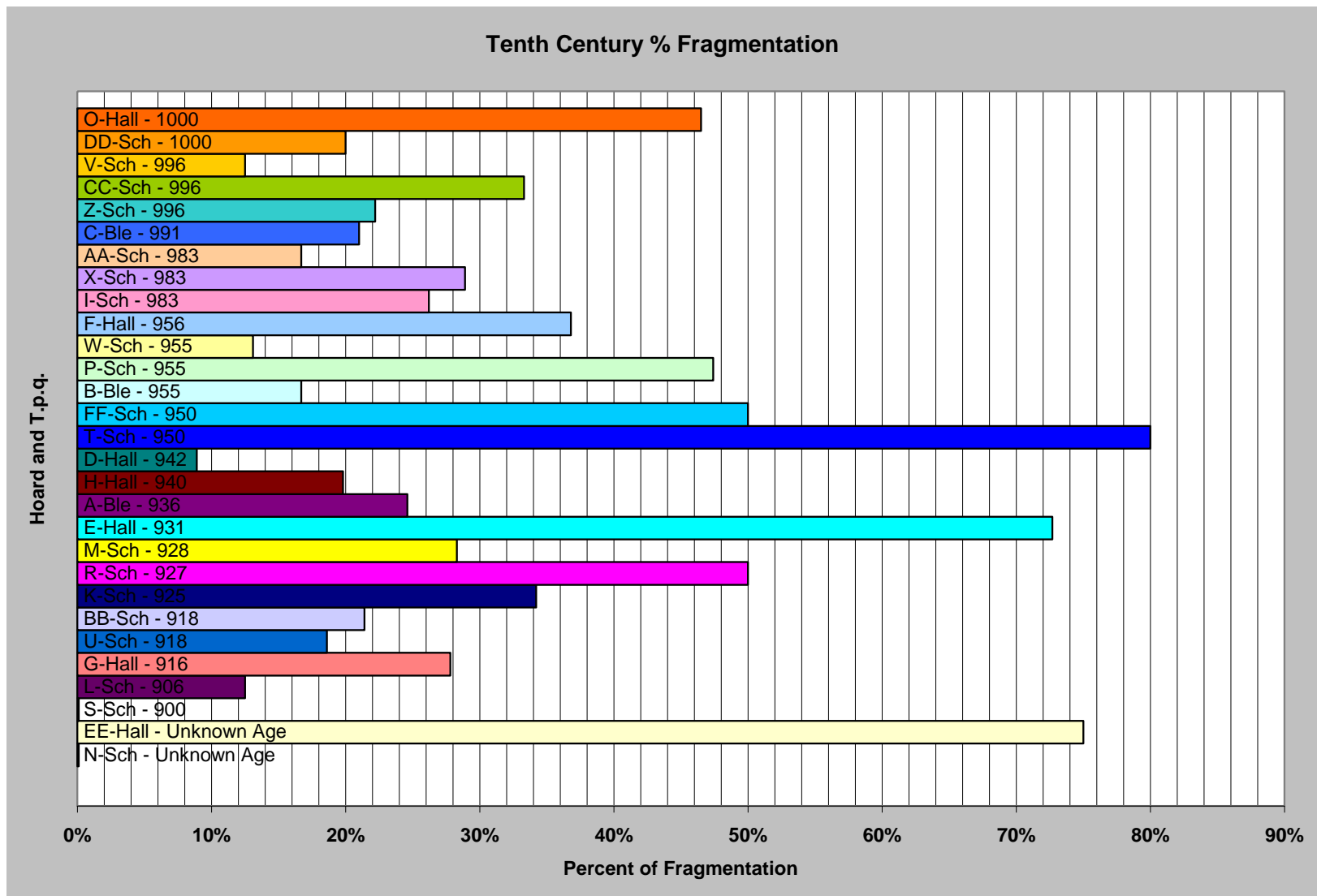

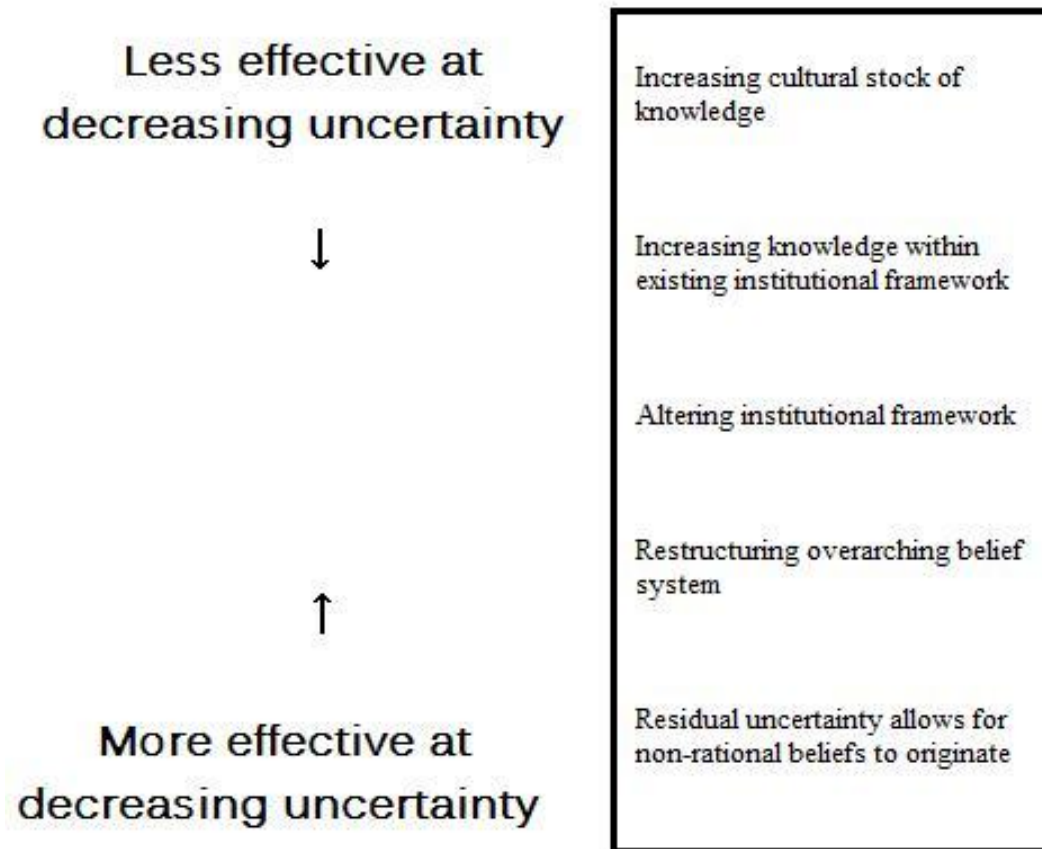


Figure 1. From North 2005.

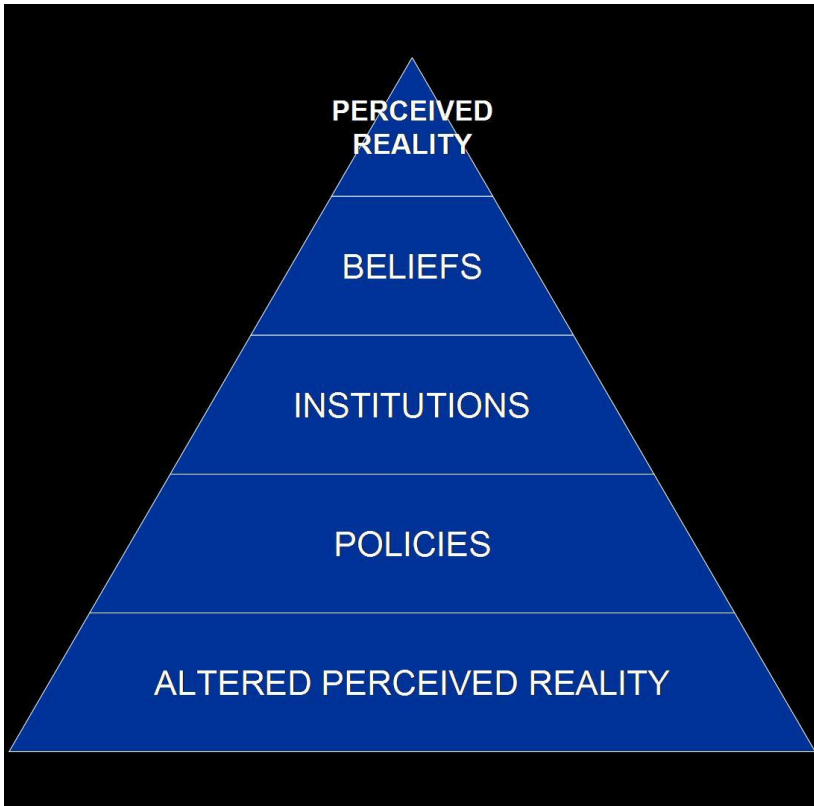
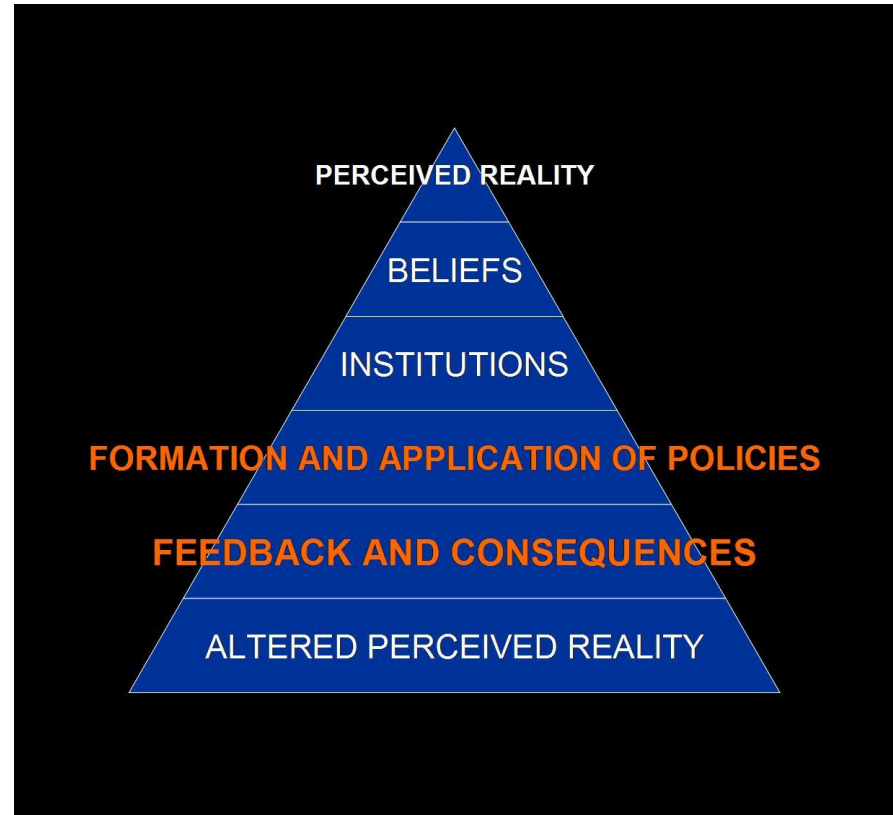


Figure 2. From North 2005.

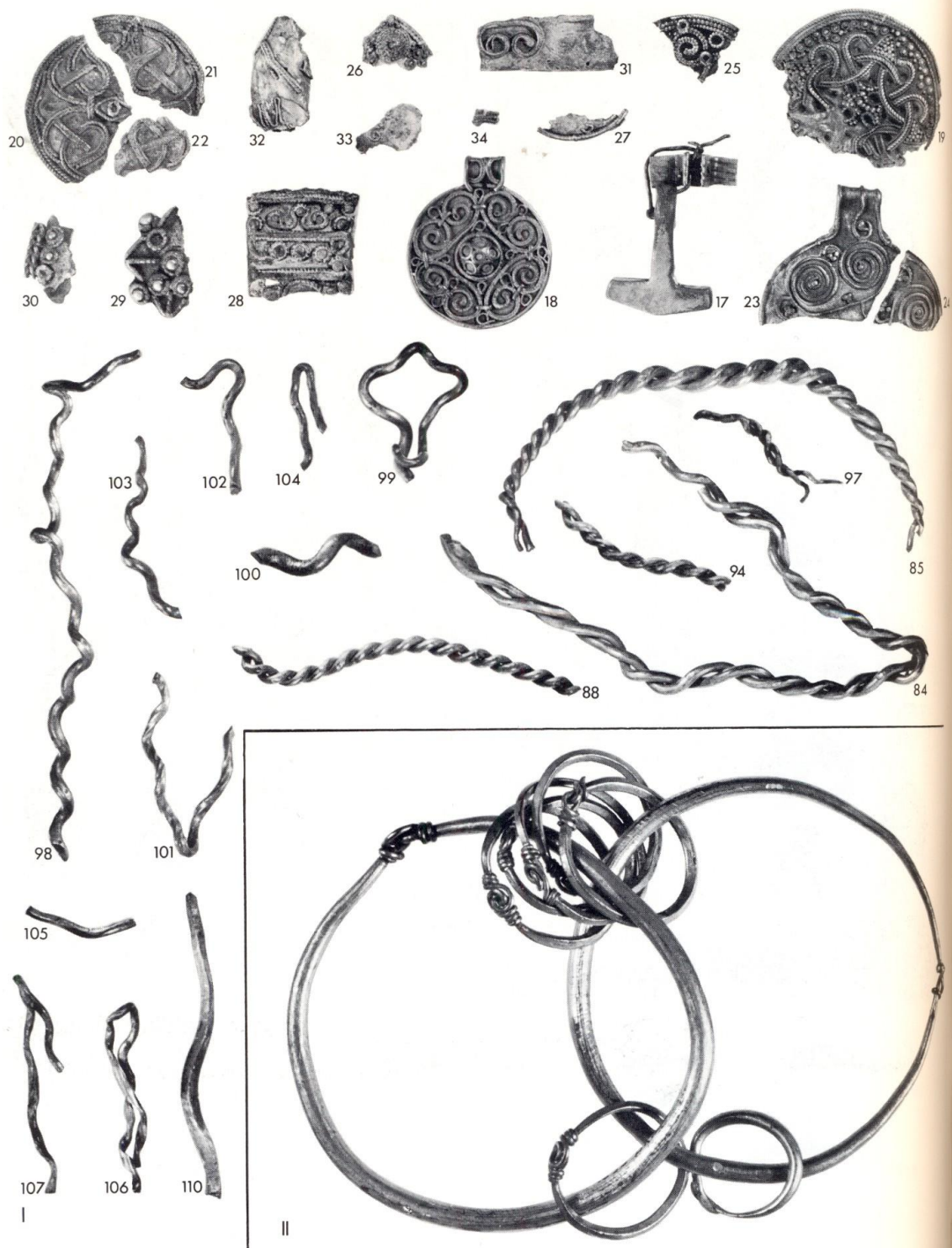


Figure 10. Selected items from Hoard K (Upper left and left). SHM 5881, 5885, 5891. Hoard N. SHM 1848. Image taken from Hårdh 1976.

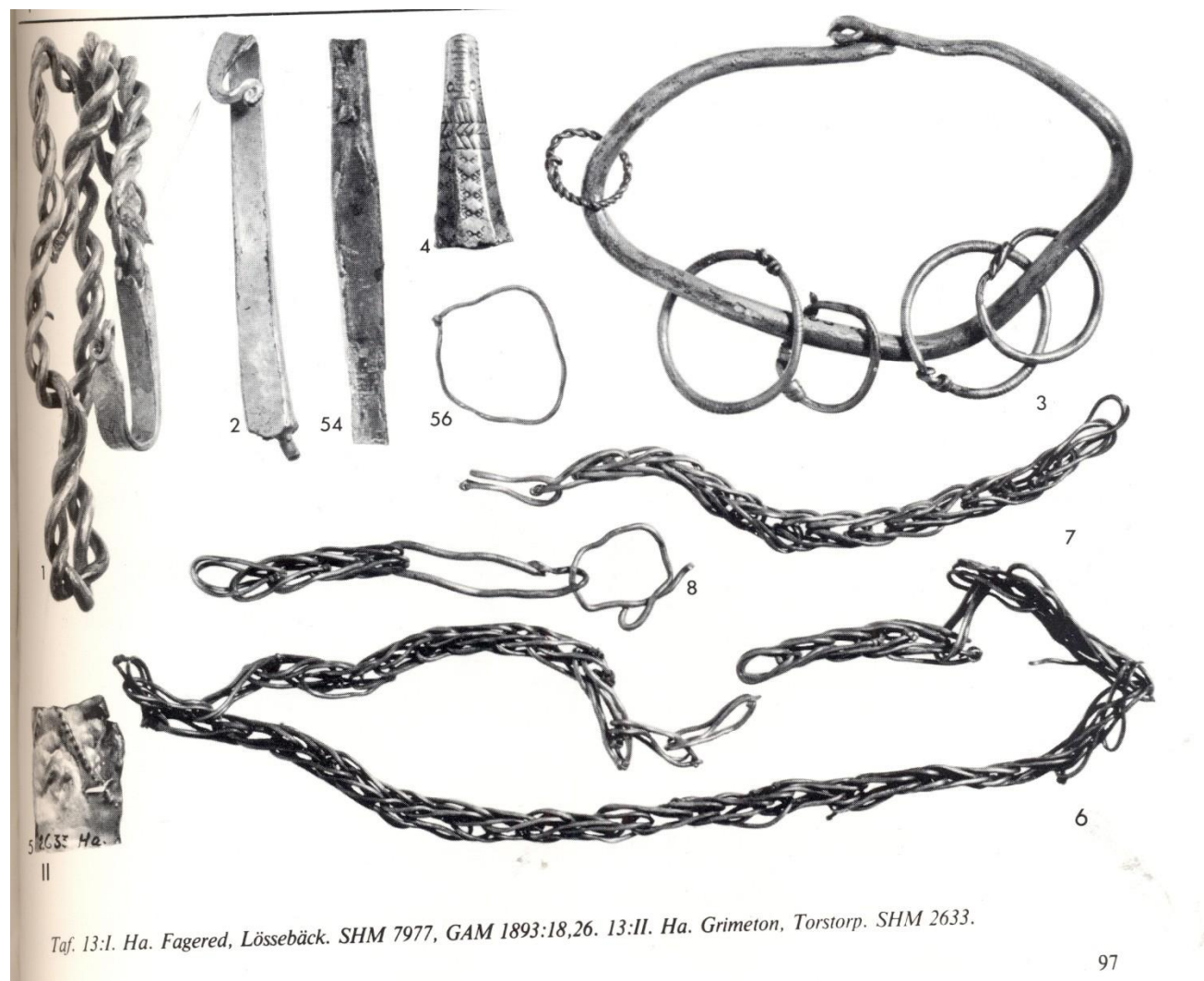
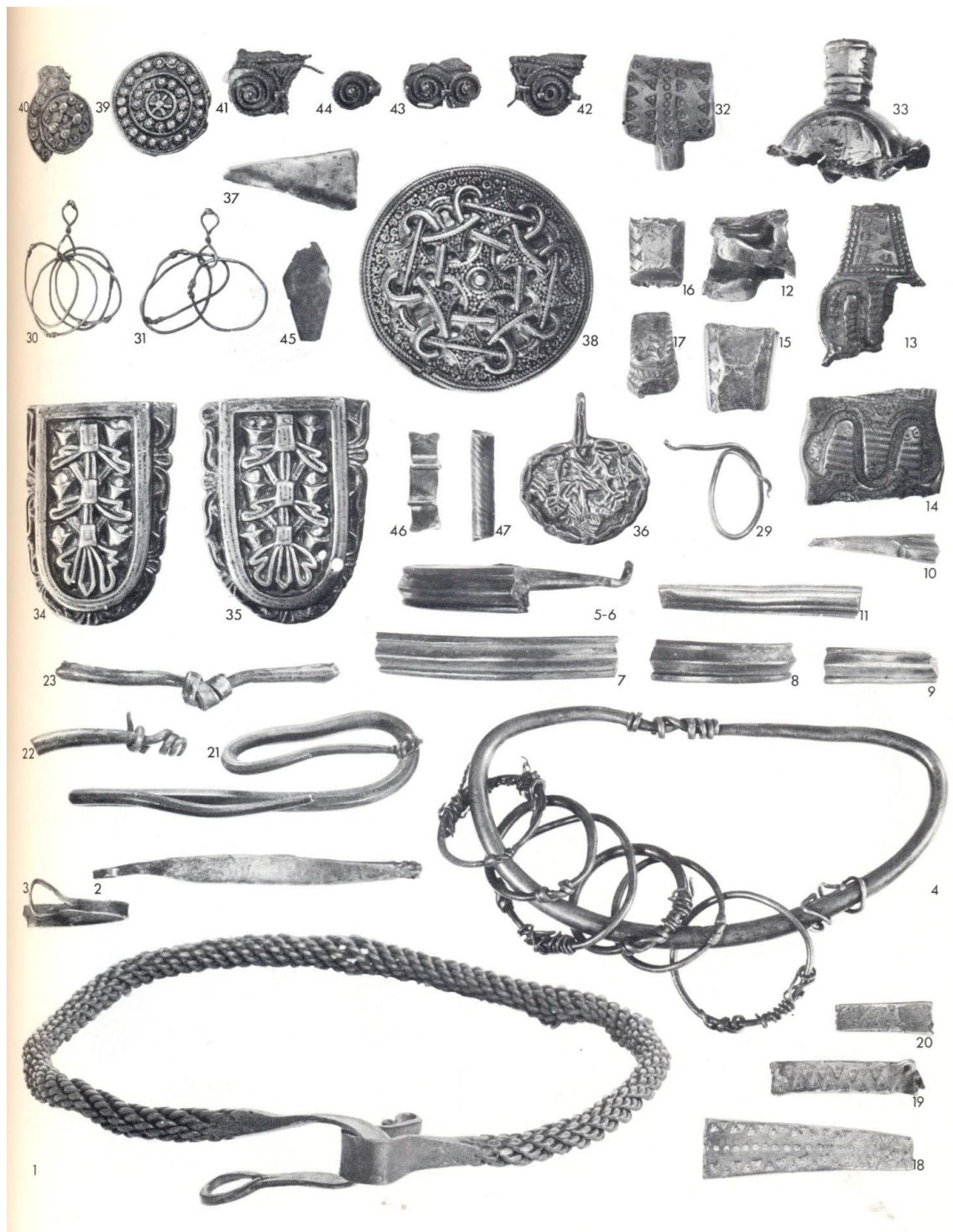


Figure 12. Selected items from Hoard D. SHM 2633.

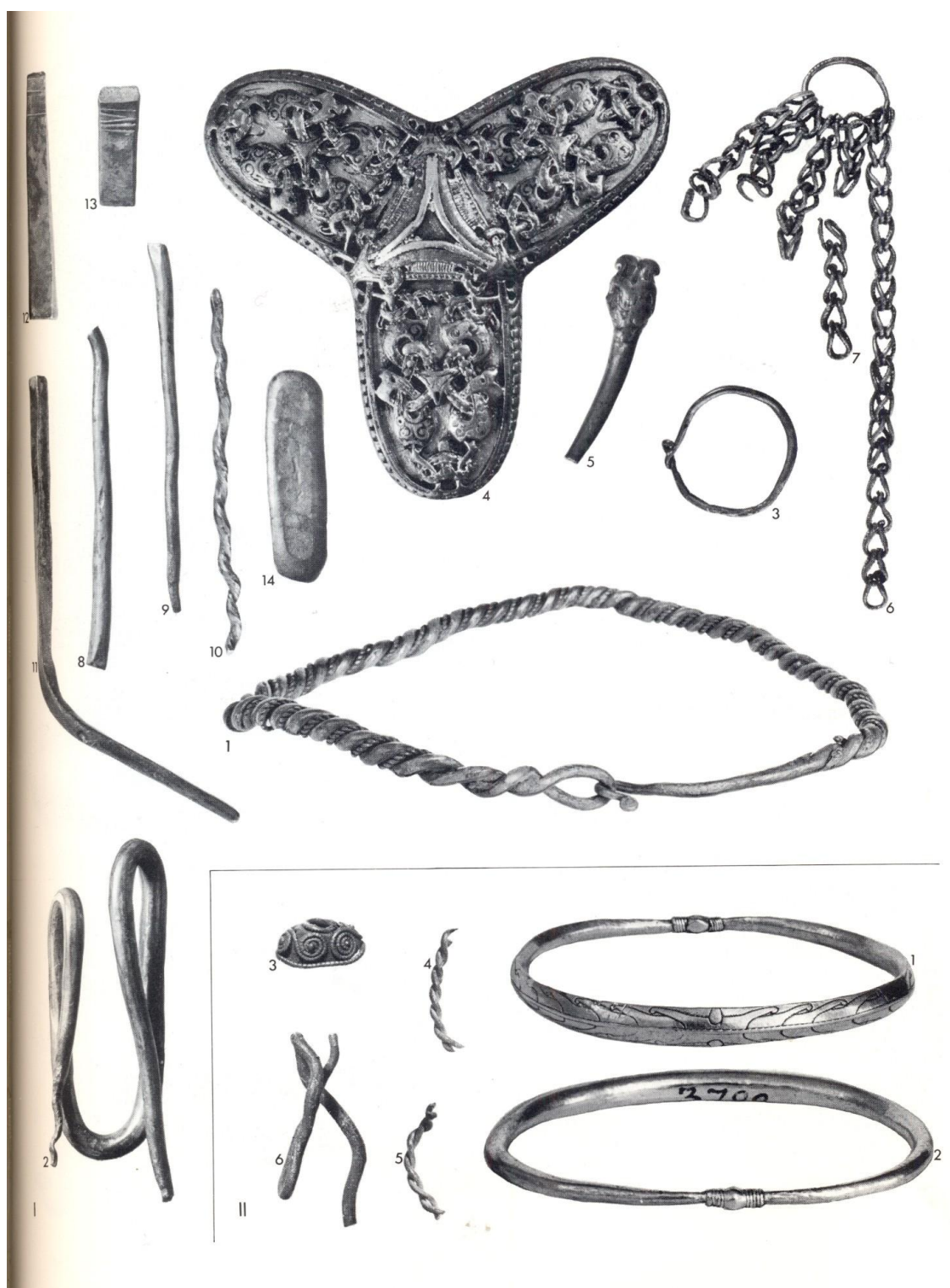


Figure 19. Hoard CC. SHM 3799.
